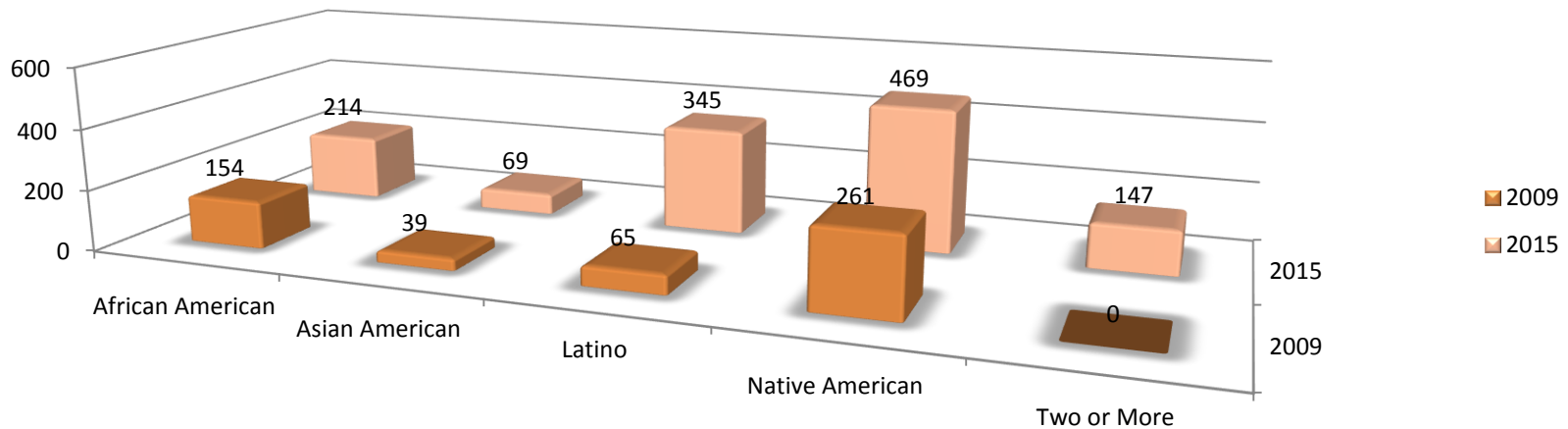

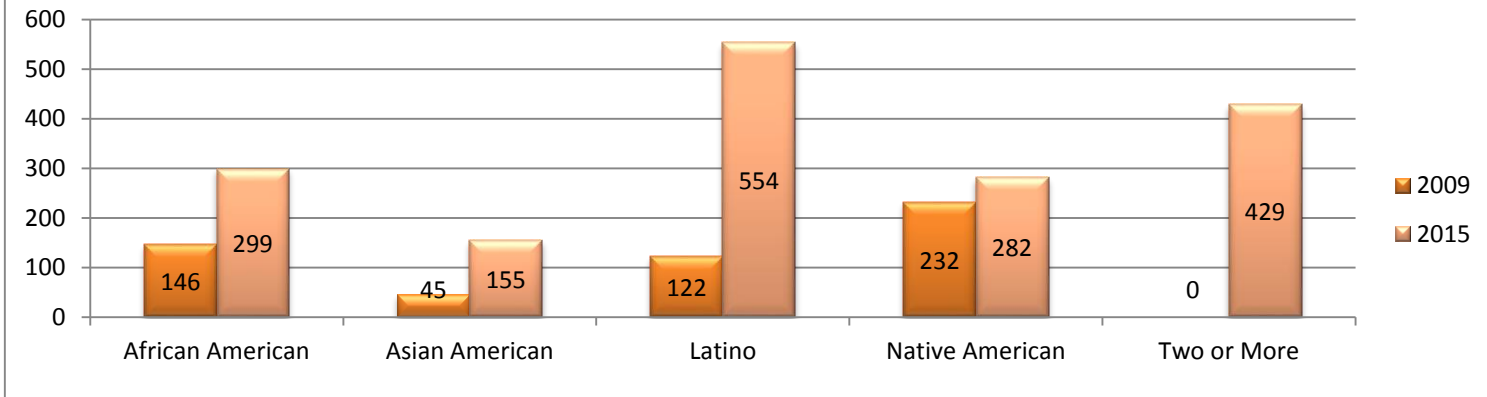

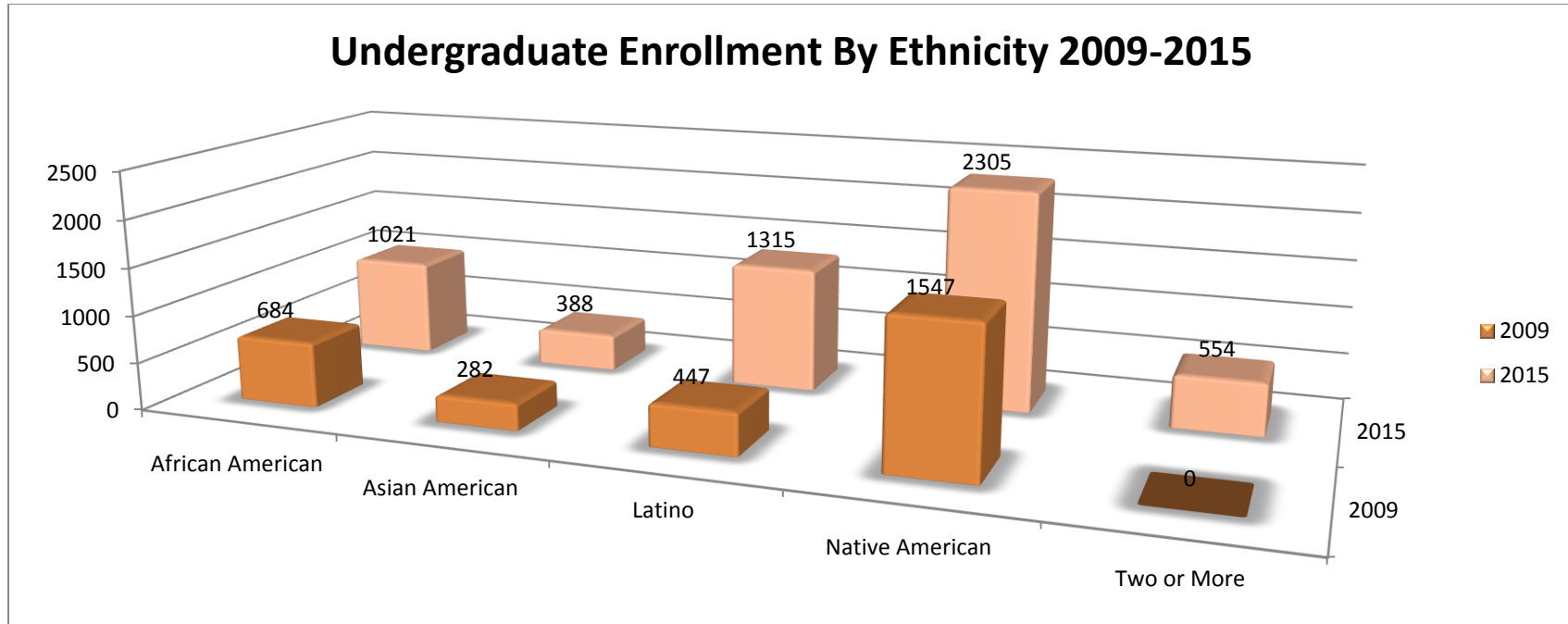

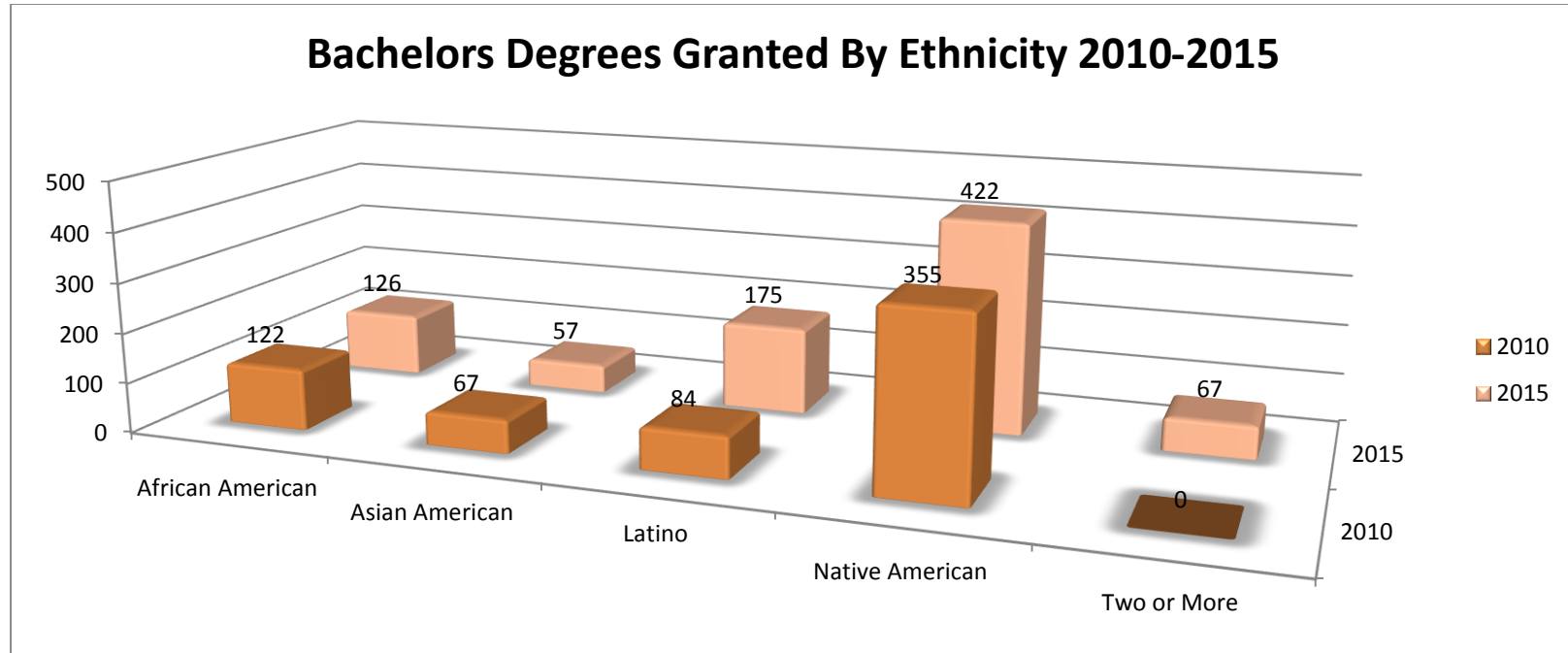

Bachelors Degrees Granted By Ethnicity 2010-2015



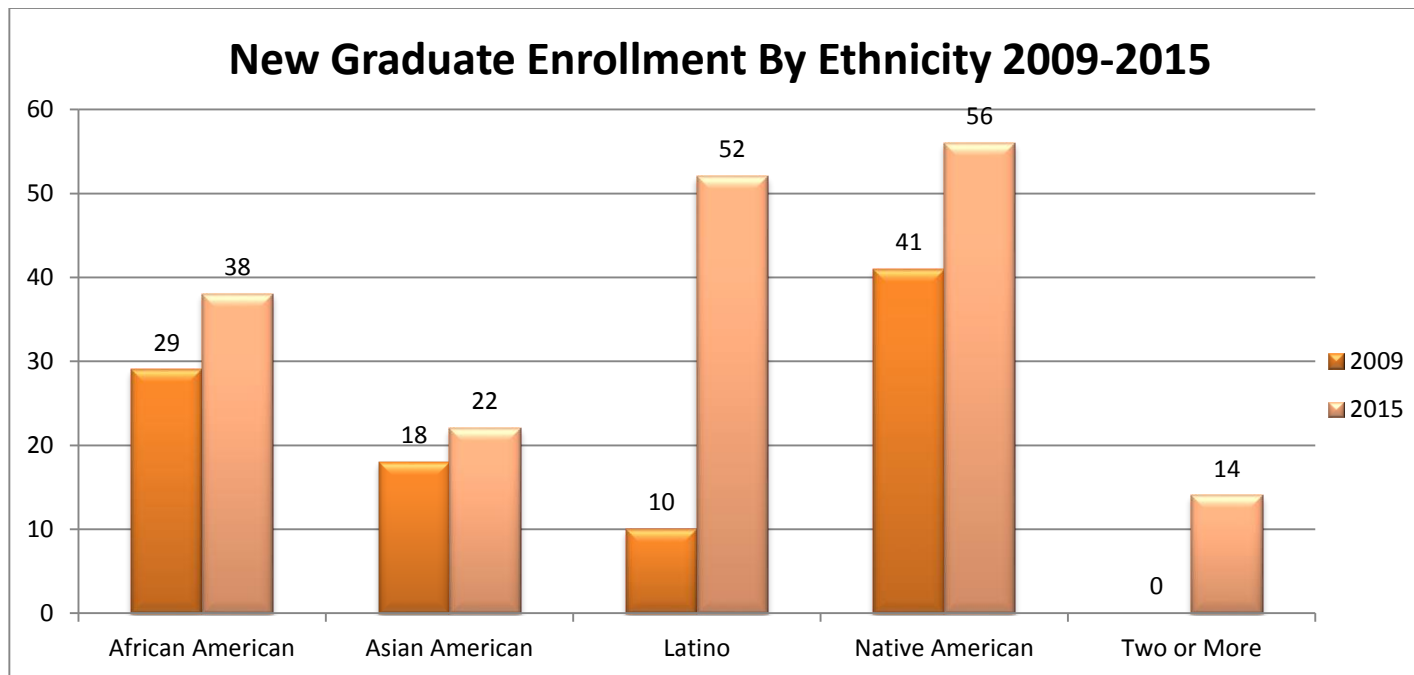

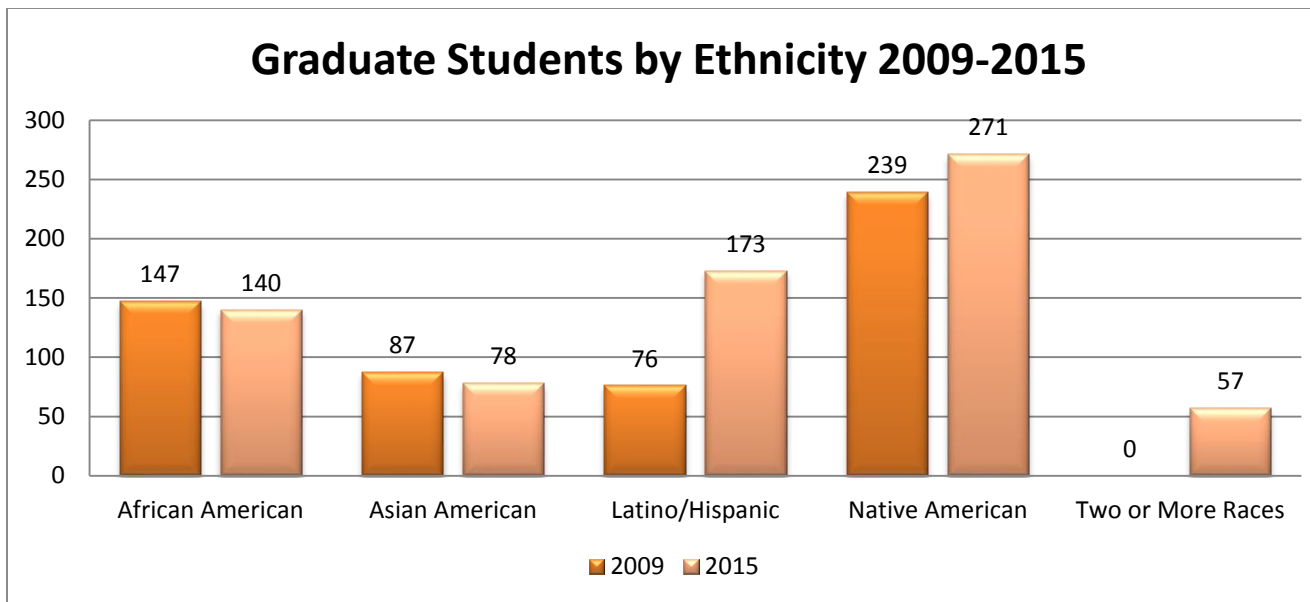

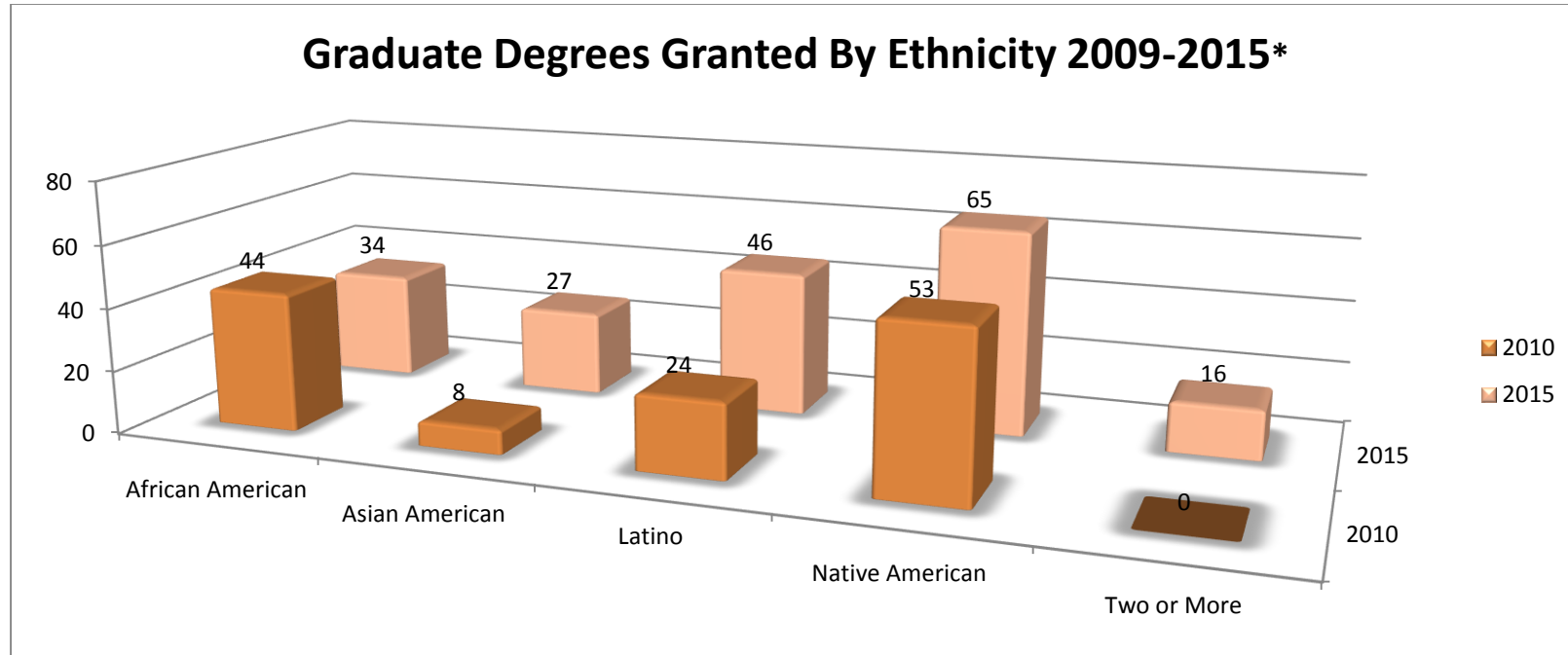

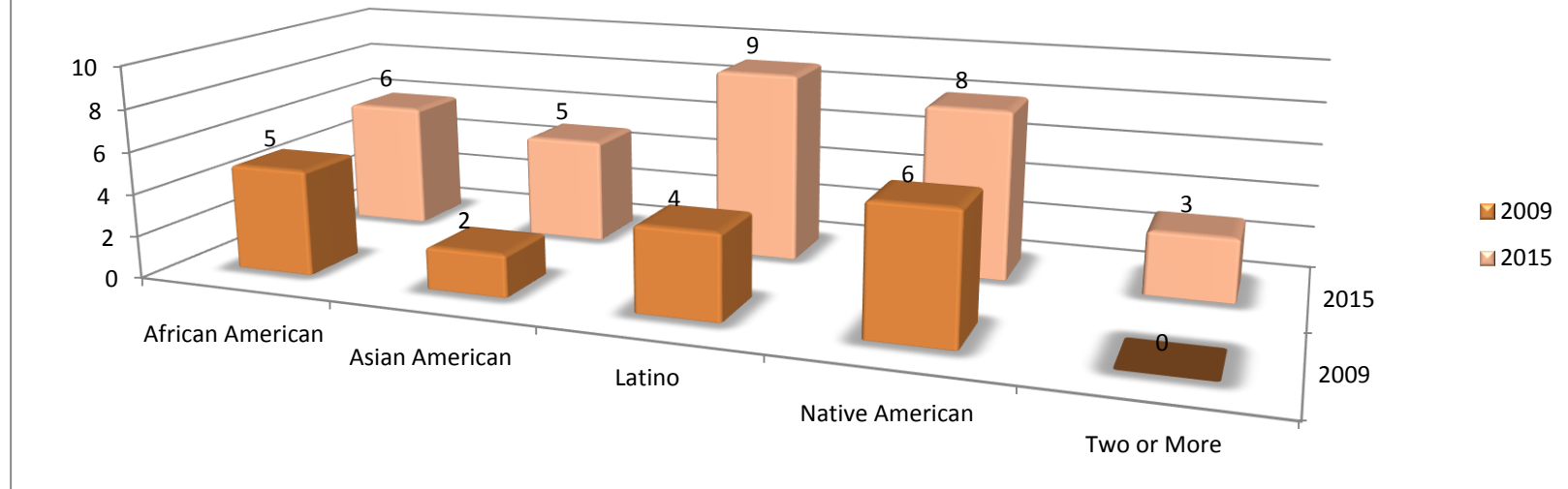

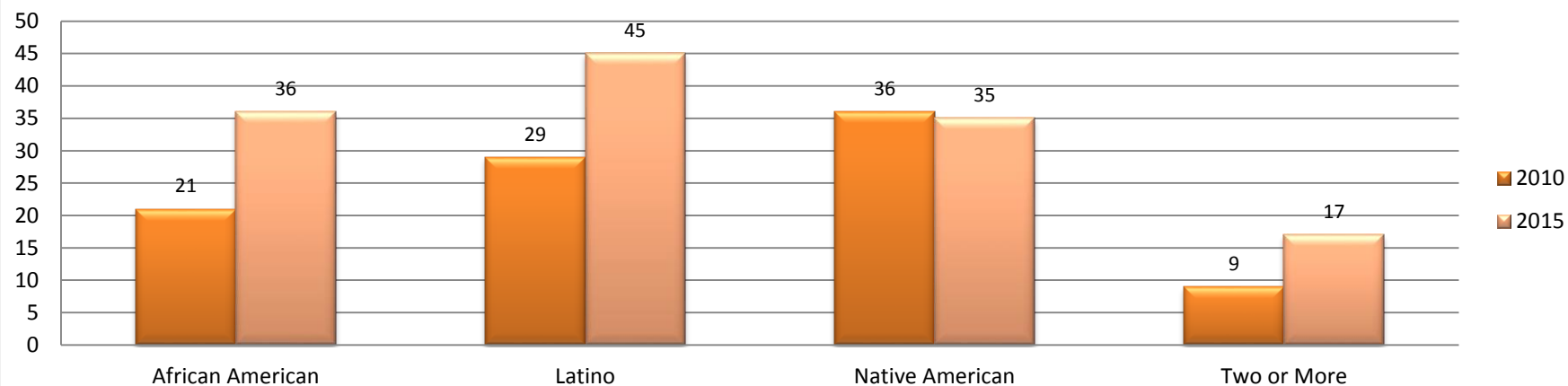
